Quilt and Fiber Exhibition 2012
"MAD ABOUT COLOR"

Theme: "**Mad About Color**" An exhibition featuring quilts and fiber art that use color in an interesting or exciting way. The exhibit is intended to showcase both traditional and art quilts and fiber art that will convey the excitement that color can bring to our world.

Juror: **Arturo Alonzo Sandoval, American Craft Fellow**

Arturo Alonzo Sandoval is a fiber artist whose experimental techniques and expressive interpretations have earned him an international reputation. A Professor of Art at the University of Kentucky Arturo has earned the respect of his students and the admiration of Lexington, his home town, and its art community.

Arturo is one of Kentucky's most original, influential and significant artists. His work is in the collections of the New York City Museum of Modern Art's Architecture and Design Collection, as well as galleries and private collections throughout the United States and the world.

Eligibility and Guidelines:

- Entry is by digital images only (see photo guidelines below)
- Quilt and Fiber Artists residing in the United States
- Up to two entries may be submitted
- Entries must be created after December 31, 2007.
- Entries must be a maximum of 85" per side
- Entries that are accepted and arrive not prepared for hanging will be disqualified.
 - Quilts must have a hanging sleeve/ or Velcro loop and hook hanging arrangement.
 - 2D fiber works must be prepared for hanging as mentioned above for quilts.
 - 3D fiber works must be prepared for display on a pedestal or display mechanism that you provide.
- All quilt entries must employ the basic structural format or layers of a quilt.
- Fiber entries must consist of a majority of fiber materials.
- There is a \$25.00 non-refundable entry fee for the two entries.
- Provide a SASE postcard for notification of acceptance if not using email.

Calendar:

December 22, 2011 Call for entry
February 10, 2012 Entry deadline - all digital entries and submission fees must be received.
February 11, 2012 Jury Date
February 13, 2012 Notification of acceptance by e-mail and/or artist provided postcard.
February 24, 2012 Selected artwork **must** have arrived at the Gateway Regional Arts Center in Mt. Sterling, KY.

Guidelines for Submission:

- Label with title, dimensions, artist name and address.
 - Quilts: Attach label on backside lower right corner of entry.
 - Fiber Art: Attach or include label as for quilts or as appropriate.
 - Completed entry form and CD images for each entry with a full image and detail image of each. Ship your CD entries in a padded envelope. The Gateway Regional Arts Council is not responsible for damaged CD entries.
 - Include a \$25.00 non-refundable entry fee, check or money-order payable to The Gateway Regional Arts Center.
 - Mail Entry forms to The Gateway Regional Arts Center, 101 East Main Street, Mount Sterling, KY 40353.

Photo Tips Guide:

It is recommend to use a minimum 4 MP (megapixel) digital camera, on highest resolution setting, saved as a JPEG file. Please provide your images at 300 dpi. Each image should be 1800 pixels wide x 1200 pixels in height or 6" x 4". Photograph in the brightest indirect light you can, not direct sunlight or flash, or the colors may be washed out. **Entries deemed significantly different from the entry digital images may be disqualified.**
